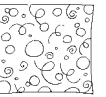
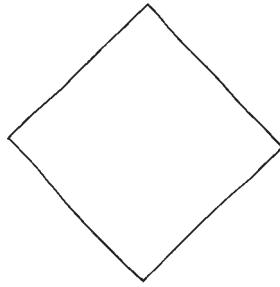


## 4 Under collar drape



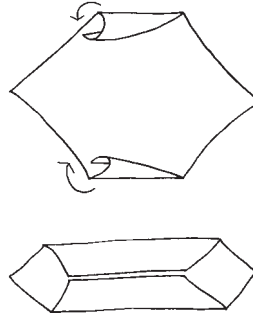
a

place your scarf on a flat surface in a diamond shape



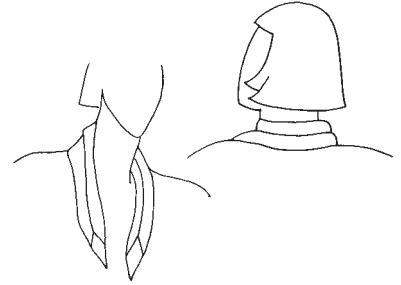
b

place the scarf evenly around your neck with rolls facing outwards and draping to the front

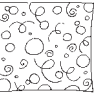

No. 1 SQUARE

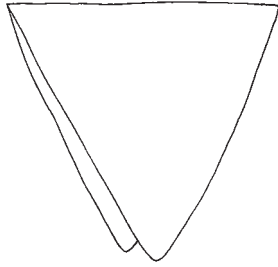




# 1 Single shoulder drape

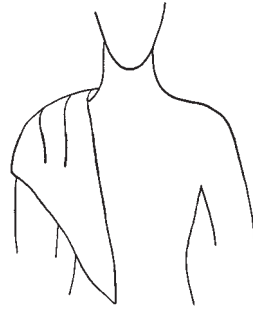
a

fold your scarf in half diagonally to form a triangle



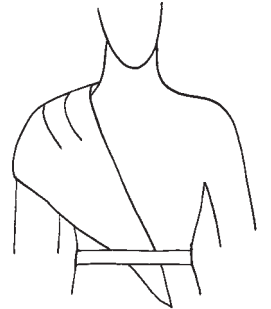
b

drape it over either shoulder



c

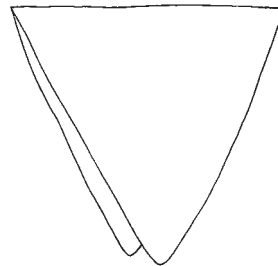
you can also secure your scarf under a belt or with a brooch



# 2 Tied drape

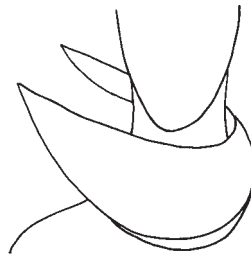
a

fold your scarf in half diagonally to form a triangle



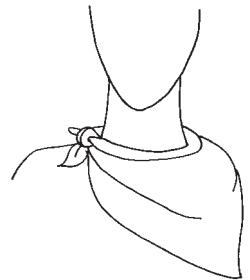
b

drape the folded scarf over either shoulder



c

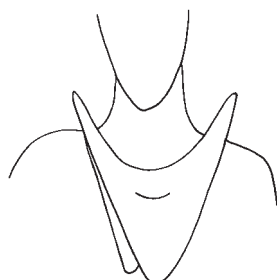
tie the ends and arrange at desired angle such as knot to front, side or back



# 3 Neck warmer/splash of colour

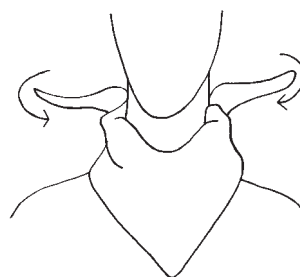
a

with your scarf folded as a triangle (1a/2a), place its centre at the front and bring each end to the back of your neck (like a bib!)

cross the ends over and bring them forward



c

tie a loose knot at the front and arrange the scarf to your liking
